Dates for the readings (3), discussion and vote will be determined later once the committee analyzes the suggestion(s) for appropriateness and monetary effects. Members will be notified of the dates sometime in November 2017.

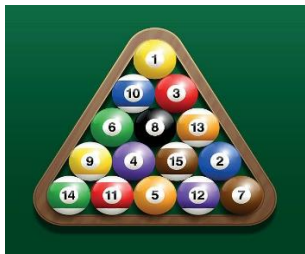
